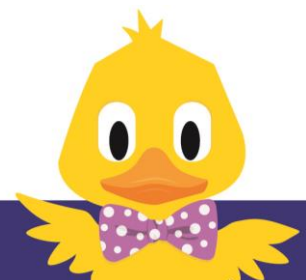

SHOW REGULATIONS

1. All competitors must be a member of the Artistic Blacksmiths Association South Australia (A.B.A.S.A) or affiliated associations.
2. All competitors and their entries will be at the discretion of the Convener.
3. All competitors **MUST** supply and wear appropriate safety clothing, footwear, glasses and hearing protection.



4. All competitors are to ensure the safety of others and members of the public at all times.
5. The competitions will be held on both Saturday and Sunday.
6. Competitors must list the classes they are entering on the entry form.
7. Competitors may bring their own and use top and bottom tools and fireman/striker (no electric tools allowed).
8. A variety of steel will be available alternatively competitors may bring their own.
9. Competitors to arrive at their forges 15 minutes prior to their start time for cleaning and lighting and to ensure the correct temperature at their start time.
10. Competitors are welcome to drop off their static display items or tools on Friday 27th August @3pm at the Sheep Pavilion (the Pavilion will be locked overnight).
11. Please be aware that there is NO parking on the showgrounds for competitors.

CA001 Static (made at home piece) Beginner and Intermediate

CA002 Static (made at home piece) Open

CA003 Live Forging Beginner and Intermediate (1 hour, forge a bottle opener of any description)

CA004 Live Forging Open (1 hour, forge a pair of door handles)

CA005 30 Minute Challenge (30 minutes, any saleable item of choice)

CA006 Pairs Challenge (make an item of choice using a random parcel of steel provided, using a minimum of 2 or 4 pieces provided. 2 hours for design and 1 hour 20 minutes for construction).
